What's new in Omnissa Certification?

1. What is changing with Omnissa Certification Program?

Starting Aug 29,2025, Omnissa is changing its certification program to make it more accessible and flexible for participants. As a result, the newly launched certifications will no longer require mandatory training prerequisite.

2. Is Omnissa launching some new credentials?

Yes! On Aug 29, 2025, Omnissa will release two credentials, mapped to task and skills required by Omnissa Horizon and Workspace ONE administrators:

- Omnissa Certified Administrator (OCA) Horizon
- Omnissa Certified Administrator (OCA) Workspace ONE

Omnissa Certified Administrator (OCA)?

1. What is the Omnissa Certified Administrator (OCA) certification?

The Omnissa Certified Administrator (OCA) credentials validate essential skills for managing Horizon and Workspace ONE environments:

- OCA Horizon: Focuses on deploying, managing, troubleshooting, and optimizing virtual desktops and applications using Omnissa Horizon, App Volumes, and Dynamic Environment Manager.
- OCA Workspace ONE: Covers deployment, management, troubleshooting, and optimization of Workspace ONE UEM, Access, and Unified Access Gateway.

2. Is the OCA same as the existing OCP certification?

No. The OCA for Horizon and Workspace ONE (WS1) are entirely new, built on redesigned blueprints that reflect updated job roles and technologies

Additionally, unlike previous certifications, no course prerequisites are required to take the OCA exams.

3. What happens to the OCP certification?

OCP exams will be retired on August 29, 2025. After this date:

- No new OCP exam registration will be allowed.
- If you have already scheduled an OCP exam, you can still take it as planned.

• If you are already OCP certified, Omnissa will continue honor your credential as a prerequisite for OCAP exams.

4. I have already scheduled an OCP exam for later this year. What are my options?

If you have already scheduled an OCP exam with Pearson VUE, you have two choices:

- 1. Proceed with your scheduled OCP exam. For pre-registered candidates, Pearson VUE will continue to deliver OCP exams.
- 2. Cancel your registration in Pearson VUE and receive a full refund. You can then register for the new OCA exam in Clarus.

5. I'm already an OCP certified professional. Will my existing OCP certification still count?

Yes. Omnissa will continue honor all *valid OCP* credentials as a prerequisite for OCAP exams.

6. Is it mandatory to take Omnissa course before the exam??

No. OCA exams do not require course completion.

The OCA credentials have no course completion prerequisites. However, Omnissa highly recommends that you attend following Omnissa recommended courses (ILT or On-demand) to help you prepare for the exams.

7. Do the recommended courses cover all the material needed to pass the exam?

Although the recommended courses focus on almost all areas tested in the certification exams, they do not cover all of the test materials. Knowledge that can only be gained from hands-on experience is also needed to pass the exams.

8. What happens to the OCAP certification?

The Omnissa Certified Advanced Professional (OCAP) exams will continue to be available until November 2025, after which they will be replaced by Omnissa Certified Expert (OCE) exams.

We will continue to offer a full EUC-specific certification, including both Horizon and Workspace ONE.

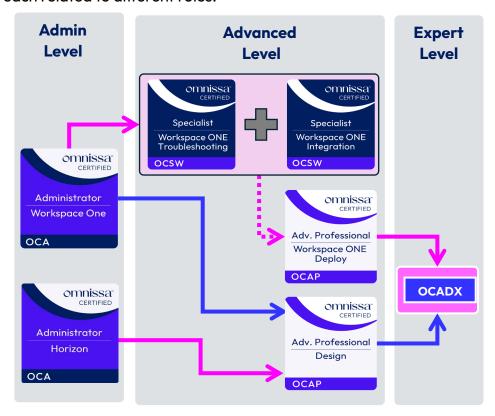

- 5. Omnissa Certified Advanced Professional Workspace ONE Deploy (OCAP WS ONE Deploy)

2. Is there a roadmap for Omnissa Certifications?

Yes. Omnissa certifications are organized into three levels based on role and expertise:

- Administrator Level Entry-level certifications for foundational skills (e.g., OCA)
- Advanced Level Intermediate certifications for deployment and design (e.g., OCAP)
- Expert Level High-level certifications for architecture and strategy (e.g., OCADX)

Omnissa offers Desktop Management and Digital Workspace certifications tracks, each related to different roles.



3. Where do I go to view details about available Certifications?

4. What is the validity of Omnissa exams?

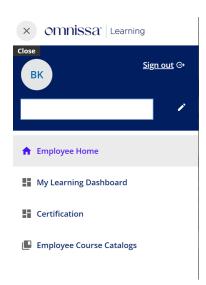
All Omnissa credentials have a **two-year validity** from the credential issue date.

6. I am logged in to https://learning.omnissa.com/learn, but I do not see any Certification tab. Where do I go to view details about the Omnissa Certification?

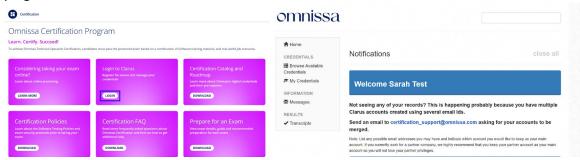

Certification Registration in Clarus

1. Where do I go to register for Omnissa exams?

Use our new Certification management tool, Clarus, to browse available credentials and register for exams. Use **Login to Clarus** tile on the Certification page to SSO to Clarus.

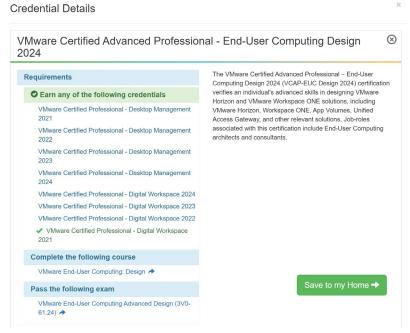


2. What is the process of registering for credentials on Clarus?

To search for and register for an Omnissa exam, please perform the following steps:

- a. From your Clarus candidate Home, click Browse Available Credentials
- b. Click on your desired credential.
- c. All requirements for the credential are listed. All your Course Completions and preexisting credentials are auto-migrated to Clarus. The requirement

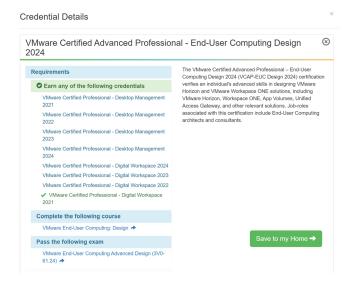
that you meet is check marked by Clarus.



- d. Use the **Save to my Home**.
- e. To schedule the exam, click on the exam name hyperlink from your home page.
- f. Click **Continue at Pearson VUE** from your candidate home to schedule your exam.
- 3. When I click on an exam name to register for the exam, I am getting an error stating that I am ineligible to appear for the credential. Why?

Mandatory training completions are required for most certifications (virtual or in-person instructor-led training or On Demand).

Also, candidates need to complete an OCP to be eligible to earn their OCAP Design or Deploy certification. All your Course Completions and preexisting credentials are auto-migrated to Clarus. The requirement that you meet is check marked by Clarus.



If all pre-requisites (course and exam) listed in Clarus are not met, you will not be allowed to register for the exam.

Scheduling Exam in Pearson VUE

4. How do I schedule an Omnissa exam in VUE?

After you click **Continue at Pearson VUE** from your candidate home in Clarus, you will be automatically single sign on to VUE. To schedule your exam, please use the following steps:

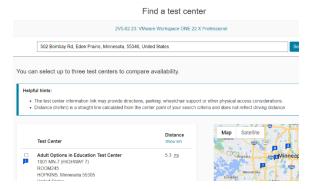

c) Select a test center:



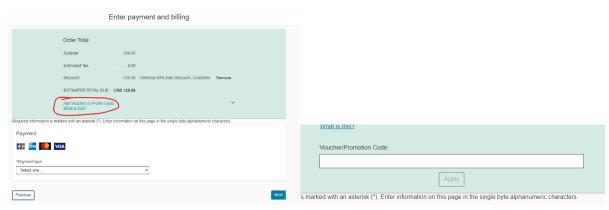
d) Select exam date and time and click Book the Appointment.

Please ensure that you schedule a date *before Feb 1, 2025*, to get Omnissa certifications free of charge.



5. Where do I apply the voucher code to get 100% discount?

On the final Payment and Billing page, click on the **Add Voucher or Promo Code** link, enter the provided voucher code and click **Apply**.



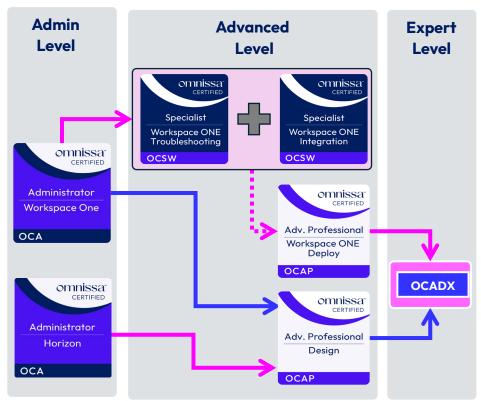
Prerequisites

1. Will Omnissa certifications require mandatory certification prerequisites?

Yes, some certifications do. For example, to earn OCAP- Workspace ONE Deploy credential, you must first complete the OCA- Workspace ONE certification.

Clarus will automatically verify your eligibility based on completed courses and credentials.

Here is a visual representation of the Omnissa Certification pathway.



2. Are there any mandatory training prerequisites as well?

No! Starting Aug 29,2025, Omnissa is changing its certification program to make it more accessible and flexible for participants. As a result, the newly launched certifications will no longer require mandatory training prerequisite.

However, training is still strongly recommended to help you prepare.

3. I completed VCP-DTM in 2023; am I exempt from OCA-H?

Yes! Omnissa will continue to acknowledge all *unexpired* Horizon and Workspace ONE product suite certifications. Here is a mapping of new Omnissa Credential names and their equivalent legacy counterpart.

Pricing and Discount

1. What is the cost for the Certification exams?

Certification pricing has been standardized for all exams. As a result, OCA, OCAP and Specialist certifications will be globally priced at USD\$250.

2. How do I download certificates for the Credentials?

Omnissa issues a Certificate of Completion that a candidate can download to validate and showcase their Omnissa abilities to clients, employers, and colleagues. To download the certificate for your recent credentials, please use the following steps:

- Login to Clarus (http://omnissa.useclarus.com)
- If you are not logged in learning.omnissa, you will be redirected to https://learningaccess.omnissa.com/login for SSO.
- On your Clarus Dashboard, click My Credentials.
- Use the download icon () to download your certificate.

3. How do I link my credential badge to my LinkedIn Profile?

Omnissa now issues verified Badges to individuals who have completed Omnissa certifications. Candidates can attach the badges to their LinkedIn profiles straight from the Omnissa Certification portal. These badges serve as concrete evidence of

Horizon and Workspace ONE skills at different levels, assuring employers, clients, and colleagues of candidate competence.

- 4. My active legacy VMware credentials are available on the "My Credentials" page, but the download icon () to download your certificate is missing. Why?

Omnissa recognizes all active legacy VMware certifications for prerequisite purposes, making them visible. However, certifications and badges are only awarded for credentials granted by Omnissa after July 2024.

5. How do I download my legacy VMware credentials and transcripts (the ones that earned before July 9th, 2024)?

All historical Certification data will be available via Certmetrics and Credly.

6. How do I obtain transcripts of existing certifications (the ones I gained via the legacy VMware Certification program),

To download your historical transcripts, please use the following steps:

- Login to CertMetrics (https://cp.certmetrics.com/ vmware/en/login/sso/oidc)
- Click Track your Certification Status
- Click VIEW MORE > for your Active certifications.
- Click on the Badge
- Download the PDF by clicking Download Certificate.
- 7. When I logged in to Clarus, I did not see any of my existing credentials. What can I do?

This is probably happening because you have multiple accounts. Send an email to <u>Certification_Support@omnissa.com</u> asking for your accounts to be merged.

List any possible email addresses you may have and indicate which account you would like to keep as your main account. If you currently work for a partner company, we highly recommend that you keep your partner account as your main account so you will not lose your partner privileges.

8. I experienced technical difficulties during the live lab exam. What should I do?

If you experience a technical issue with the live lab availability or functionality during the exam, please report it to the exam proctor immediately. Ask for a Pearson VUE VSS support ticket to be created. If no VSS support ticket is created, Omnissa will not be able to review or confirm any issues experienced. Issues reported after the exam cannot be validated.
