
They include the intensified **cleaning and disinfection** of surfaces and sanitary facilities, the provisioning of hand sanitizers (disinfection agents),

Please keep your safety distance! In the following, please note some **rules and hints how you can help support us in this context:**

Corona Test*

- **Negative test result required or**
- **Full-scale vaccination protection**
- **Proof of full recovery after Corona infection**



Use a medical mouth-and-nose protection mask.*

- **Only touch your mask at the edges.**
- **Make sure that your mouth, nose, and cheeks are completely covered.**



Wash your hands.

- **Soap them in for at least 20 seconds.**
- **Soap them in up to your wrists.**




Cough and sneeze properly.



Be careful when touching things and surfaces.

Keep a safety distance of 1.5 to 2 m.
